The Artist fuses West African mythological Symbols with the traditional body painted costume of the Native Indigenous people of Cuba whos culture has been lost and now, most recently deeply researched for several decades by contemporary scholars. Joaquín La Habana perfomance is totally inspired by his own family heritage presenting ancient chants, songs, dances and ritual images; which clearly Call and Honor the Power and the Balance of the 4 Elements of Nature, finding parallel of both of these cultures, religious concepts and images related to the Universal Forces which are represented as Deities, Fertility Godesess; each One forfilling the "2 spirits" Concept of Mythical Archeotypes that lives within each of us Human beings.

Joaquín La Habana is himself a cross cultural individual of West-African, Spanisch and Native Cuban family background (Africa: Yoruba, Bamtu, / Cuba: Tainos & Ciboneyes) He takes the audience on a journey of several Metamorphosis during his Ritual Performance which goes beyond anyones cultural borders of gender and race. Opening a new road that explores the "2 spirits" concepts which lives within each of our very own inner self.

Panel Discussion


He illustrates Cubas deverse Ethnic group differences from West Africa which where imported to the island by the transatlantic Slave handler ships.
